Conditions Relating to the Award of Prizes in

The Bickerton Challenge Rides

<u>In aid of</u>

Help 4 Heroes.

A). Non-riding Collectors of Donations.

1). The event organiser, R.D.Ackerley and his immediate family are ineligible for the prize in this category.

2). The non-riding collector of donations who hands in the most money by 31.08.10 will be awarded a prize of £50.

<u>B</u>). Individual Rider's Prize.

1). £50 will be awarded to the rider who, by 31.08.10, has handed in the greatest amount of sponsorship money to the organiser, provided that the total number of entries in all three of the Bickerton Challenge Rides is at least 25. Riders in Le Tour de Tattenhall do not count in the total numbers of riders of the Bickerton Challenge Rides.

2). This award is open to all riders in the three rides comprising the Bickerton Challenge Rides.

C). Team Prize.

 $\pounds 50$ will be awarded to the Club or CTC Group with the most riders who complete the 104 mile ride within the 12 hour time limit.

General.

1). In the event of a tie in any of the above categories, the tie will be broken by randomly drawing the name of the winner from amongst those in the tied result.

2). The prize money has been donated anonymously by a well wisher, and does not come from entry fees, other donations or sponsorship money.

3). In the event of any prize money being unallocated, it will be placed in the general fund of the event.

4). Riders in Le Tour de Tattenhall do not qualify for either of the awards under conditions B and C above, but can do so under condition A above.

5). In the event of any dispute, the decision of the President of Chester & North Wales CTC will be final.
