

## Progress on the new Burton Marsh Route

Included in this update are three photos taken by Peter Williams showing progress on the new Burton Marshes link route. Photos one and two show the construction of the boardwalk from the old steel road to the embankment. The third photo shows the exact location for those familiar with Burton Marshes. Work alongside the railway line is progressing well.

In the other direction from the bottom of Denhall Lane, work has started on the link cycle path from Station Road into Neston.



The surface of the Old Steel Road from the bottom of Station Road over the marsh as far as the Welsh border and the MOD Firing Range will be brushed and resurfaced with a tarmac/grit dressing and some work with the cattle grids.



From Denhall Farm along Quayside up to the Harp Pub as far as Marshlands Road, the two metre wide surface will have a base dressing and a tarmac/grit surface. The Pub car park is also being resurfaced.

The route then goes up Marshlands Road and left through the West Vale estate to Flint Drive. From Flint Drive the path goes through a little park past the Scout/Air Corps hut into Church Lane. This then links to the Wirral Way and NCN Route 56. The path through the park will also be two metres wide.

The site engineer will be adding signage and hopes to have the work completed in eight weeks. The completion date on the Welsh side isn't yet available.
