

Eureka Audax/C&NW CTC rides---Saturday April 25 2015

Eureka Cafe on the Wirral has been sheltering, supporting and serving cyclists since the 1930's. It is so famous, it has several documentaries to its name giving an outline of the history of the cafe and some of the many personalities associated with it.

The cafe has been used in the past as an Audax intermediate control point. However, a group of local CTC and audax riders believe that the cafe really should have its own rides starting and finishing in the cafe. So here we go again after a successful start in 2013.

"Eureka Excursion" 200k This ride is based on the Peak Audax "Eureka" route---but starting at the Cafe itself and visiting the beautiful village of Ellesmere at the southern point. The route then heads off to Bunbury, Congleton & Lymm before returning through Great Budworth to the Wirral. A generally flat ride with many interesting, scenic lanes. A qualifying ride for Paris-Brest Paris this year, for those that need it!

"Tea in Prospect" 130k rides out to Prospect Tea Rooms near the Llangollen Panorama (one big hill to reach the cafe) and then returns on mostly flat lanes via a lunch stop at Bunbury (route changed to avoid any congestion in the cafe with the 200k riders this year!).

"Two Mills Twirl" 60k is an introductory ride visiting Hildegard's Cafe in Holt followed by a return to the Eureka cafe through Aldford and Mickle Trafford.
