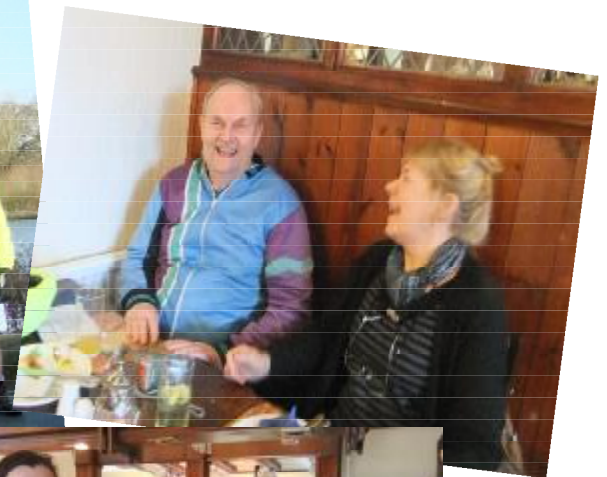


Peter, Lowri, Andy Polokowski and Martin Thomson made up the winning team.
