Notice of Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrians Order
Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14
Public Footpath No. 11 In the Community of Sealand and
Public Footpath No. 4 in the Community of East Saltney

The Flintshire County Council hereby intends not sooner than 7 days from the 10th January 2013 to make an Order which will prohibit pedestrians from using that section of Public Footpath No. 11 in the Community of Sealand from a point at NGR 33697 36588 to a point at Public Footpath No. 4 in the Community of East Saltney at NGR 33688 36573 incorporating Saltney Ferry Footbridge.

The reason for the closure is for the existing parapet to be dismantled and new parapet installed.

The alternative routes available for pedestrians are the Blue Bridge, Queensferry and the Grosvenor Bridge, Chester.

It is anticipated that the Order will come into force on the 28th January 2013, or as soon as possible thereafter. The footpath closure is expected to last until 26th April 2013, or until the earlier completion of the works, subject to a maximum period of six months.
