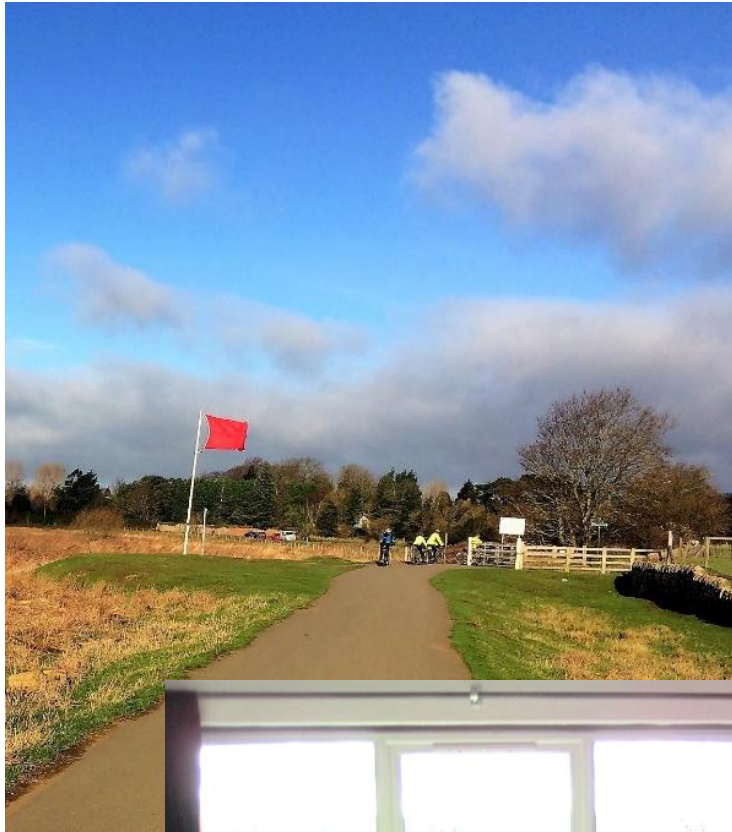


Unfortunately, on that stretch I dropped my camera but **Chris L** kindly picked it up and returned it to me when I promptly dropped it again.
