Abakhan Ride - 28th November 2010



It snowed heavily in **Heswall** Friday afternoon and it was still on the ground on Sunday morning, so, with the **visible snow at**

Mostyn (our destination), a temperature of -3°, and cyclists still walking along The Wirral Way, I reluctantly decided it was



unsafe to lead my ride to Abakhan.



I did however,

drive to **The Eureka café**, where a few hardy stalwarts had assembled, to explain my decision and offer a printed route to anyone who wanted it. Only four Two Mills members had arrived by 10.15am, none were planning to ride far, so, after a delicious bacon sandwich, I drove home and spent my day creating this report!

So, here it is then: a **virtual rather than real account** of what would have been seen, had the ride taken place.

Down to the A 548, passing the



Shotton Paper Mill, over the Flint Bridge, with views of the Shotton Steel Mill and Connahs

Quay power station.







Flint Leisure Centre for a quick 11ses before continuing along the coast road passed what had once been the Courtaulds huge factory complex (1913-1986), producing artificial silk from wood pulp, finally demolished in 1986.







Weather permitting, leaving the main road and climbing up to **Holywell** through the **Greenfield Heritage Site**, marvelling at this long since disappeared extensive and important early industrial area.
