Sue's Holyhead to Chester Bike Ride 16-17 June 2009 As part of Chester and North Wales Anniversary Year celebrations and as part of Bike Week, Sue Booth (Chester and North Wales CTC Development Officer) and CTC member Sonya Oldershaw are cycling from Holyhead to Chester following National Cyclerooute 5 (NC 5), starting at Holyhead Railway Station and ending at Chester, Town Hall Square. Sue and Sonya are setting off from Holyhead at about 9 in the morning on Tuesday 16th June, passing through Bangor for lunch at about 1pm, Llanfairfechan at about 3pm and Conwy at tea time. Wednesday will see a later departure (by 10.15am) heading to Colwyn Bay for 11am to meet with a North Wales Coast cycling group, and continuing via Pensarn to Talacre at about 1.30pm, where rumour has it there is a very good cake shop and hostelry. Leaving Talacre at about 2pm, the girls will be heading back up the Dee Estuary and should be in Holywell for 3pm, Connah's Quay for 4pm, and arrive back in Chester at about 5pm. The entry fee for these rides is £12 for adults and £6 for children under 13 yrs of age on 1st March 2009. The menu consists of a two-course meal plus cheese and biscuits, coffee and mints and a slice of a beautifully made CH&NW 70th anniversary birthday cake.
