CTC and Charitable Status The CTC National AGM will be held in Loughborough on 15<sup>th</sup> May 2010. A key item on the Agenda will be the proposed adoption by CTC of full Charitable Status. Council is very keen that members are fully consulted on this important issue and so far have placed articles in 'Cycle' magazine in the Feb/Mar, Apr/May, Oct/Nov 2009 editions. The 2009 AGM in Chester unanimously agreed to evaluate options, consult members and bring enabling motions to the 2010 AGM. On 24<sup>th</sup> October 2009, Council debated and supported recommendations from the Governance working group to create a unified charitable structure. Consultation with members was via 'Cycle' and Newsnet in November/December 2009. Following Council's response to consultation, a motion will be put to CTC's national AGM on 15<sup>th</sup> May 2010 at Loughborough University. The full agenda will be published in the April edition of 'Cycle'. Articles for and against the motion appeared in the February/March 2010 edition of 'Cycle'. Members who can't attend the AGM will be able to use a proxy voting form in the April/May edition of 'Cycle'. Please read the information available and use your vote.

It's vital therefore, that members pay their renewal fees on time!

Greenway section closure From the 1<sup>st</sup> March for 7 weeks, a section of the Greenway will be closed due to the construction of the new link between the Greenway, the canal and Deva Link Road. The location of the closure and a suggested diversion can be seen on our website's News page, but cyclists can also choose their own routes to avoid the closed section. A map showing the closed section will be displayed at each access point on the Greenway.

Closure at The Groves, Chester The Groves between the Old Dee Bridge and the Recorder Steps is also closed while new block paving or setts are being laid. This is going to take some time. Access is along the Walls and the Recorder Steps or via Souter's lane.

Cycling Instructors 'Cycle Experience' Cycle Instructor Training Course,  $23^{rd}$ - $26^{th}$  March 2010 North Wales (venue to be confirmed). Cycle Experience is a Bikeability provider that also trains cycle instructors. The course is a four-day introduction to the skills and knowledge required to become an accredited National Standards instructor, working with individuals or groups of all ages and abilities. Successful trainees are usually eligible for a CTC Wales bursary of £500 towards the course fees. Further information and links are on our website's News page.
