Rides

<u>LE TOUR DE TATTENHALL</u> This is a shorter ride in aid of HELP FOR HEROES and will run in conjunction with The Bickerton Challenge rides.

Le Tour de Tattenhall - 25th July 2010 is in support of the charity Help 4 Heroes. The route is 12 miles in length and route sheets will be available on the day. The ride starts at Bickerton Village Hall, on to Brown Knowl, Bolesworth Hill, Tattenhall, past the Ice Cream Farm (approximately half way round the route) and back to Bickerton via Harthill. The map reference of Bickerton Village Hall is: OS Landranger 117, SJ 509 537. Just roll up, enter and ride; the start will be open from 12.00 noon to 1.00pm. The Hall will reopen for free tea/coffee/squash and biscuits at the end of the ride from 3.00pm to 4.00pm. Entry fees are: £10 for riders over 16yrs old, £5 for those under 16yrs and £25 for Families of 2 adults + 2 children under. All proceeds to 'Help for Heroes'.
